<b>Process(es)</b>	To what extent is the community involved in the various stages of the project?	To what extent will the community benefit <i>during</i> the project?	<p>To what extent will the community's involvement contribute to advancing knowledge?</p> <p>To what extent is the scholarship on, by, and/or with the community?</p>	<p>Similar to what we ask with service-learning: to what extent will the community experience advance student (academic and civic) learning?</p>
<b>Product(s)</b>	To what extent is the community involved in determining and/or writing/creating the final product(s)?	To what extent does/will the product benefit the community?	<p>To what extent does/will the scholarly product benefit the scholar's productivity?</p> <p>To what extent does/will the scholarly product contribute to a body of knowledge?</p>	

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
