




Research Entangled With Indigenous Research Research conducted by Indigenous peoples is Indigenous

(Dunbar, 2008; Smith, 1999; Wilson, 2008)


Indigenous research is often but not necessarily Decolonizing



## Makes use of and legitimates non-Western/male <u>epistemologies</u>.

How we learn and/or think, come to know things. For example:

- Language of instruction affects learning, spirit, self-esteem, and the nature of what is learned. (Ngũgĩ, 1986)
- Community expertise/Expertise outside of the Western academy
- The ancestors
- The land, the water, the stars/sky
- Emphasis on historical research
- Women/marginalized as equals in knowledge pursuits
