

## **Call For Design Team Members: Community Engaged Scholarship – Wicked Issues**

Campus Compact is seeking applications for two individuals to join the design team for the Wicked Issues Webinar Series and Knowledge Creation. The design team will support the Campus Compact Wicked Issues Fellow in planning the webinars and generating a knowledge hub that will reside on the Campus Compact website. We aim to form a team that reflects the diversity of community engagement scholarship.

### **Scope of Work**

In partnership with the Academy of Community Engaged Scholarship (ACES), Campus Compact is committed to providing trainings and creating resources that can enhance the practice and impact of community-engaged learning and scholarship on the capacity to respond to society's wicked problems. This year, we have chosen to investigate the **wicked issue(s) found at the intersection of climate and health**.

A design team, composed of ACES members, leaders from Campus Compact member institutions, and a Campus Compact representative, will support the Wicked Issues Fellow in developing five webinars and creating a knowledge hub.

### **Timeline**

- Deadline to apply: December 12, 2025
- Webinar development phase: January 12 – February 13, 2026  
During these development sessions, the team will outline the plans, establish learning objectives, and confirm speakers for the webinars
- Webinar promotion: February 16 to March 27, 2026
- Webinars (weekly): March 30 to May 8, 2026
- Curation of resources: May 11 to May 29, 2026
- Creation of Resource Hub: June 1 – June 26, 2026

### **Design Team Details**

Time Commitment: The design team will meet together with the fellow for approximately 90 minutes each week during the webinar development phase

(between January 12 and February 13, 2026). Following the development phase, the design team will likely have minimal involvement with the project. We will ask the design team to promote the webinars in their networks and they will be encouraged to attend the webinars. After the webinars conclude, formal meetings will resume to assist the fellow in curating resources that will be used to create the resource hub. The time commitment from May 11 – June 26, will be approximately 1-2 hours per week.
