Community College Rates

For two-year institutions, we offer a flat annual rate based on college total full time enrollment (FTE). This prioritizes access for community colleges and creates a simple pathway to allow a greater number of two-year institutions to engage with and benefit from the Campus Compact network.

5,001-8,000	\$3,500

Four-year College & University Rates

Our revised dues schedule* for four year institutions is a function of total FTE and instructional expense per student. By taking instructional expense per student into account, we incorporate an equity measure into our dues equation—it's a good proxy for an institution's financial resources.
